2. Ashley Bianca-age 12

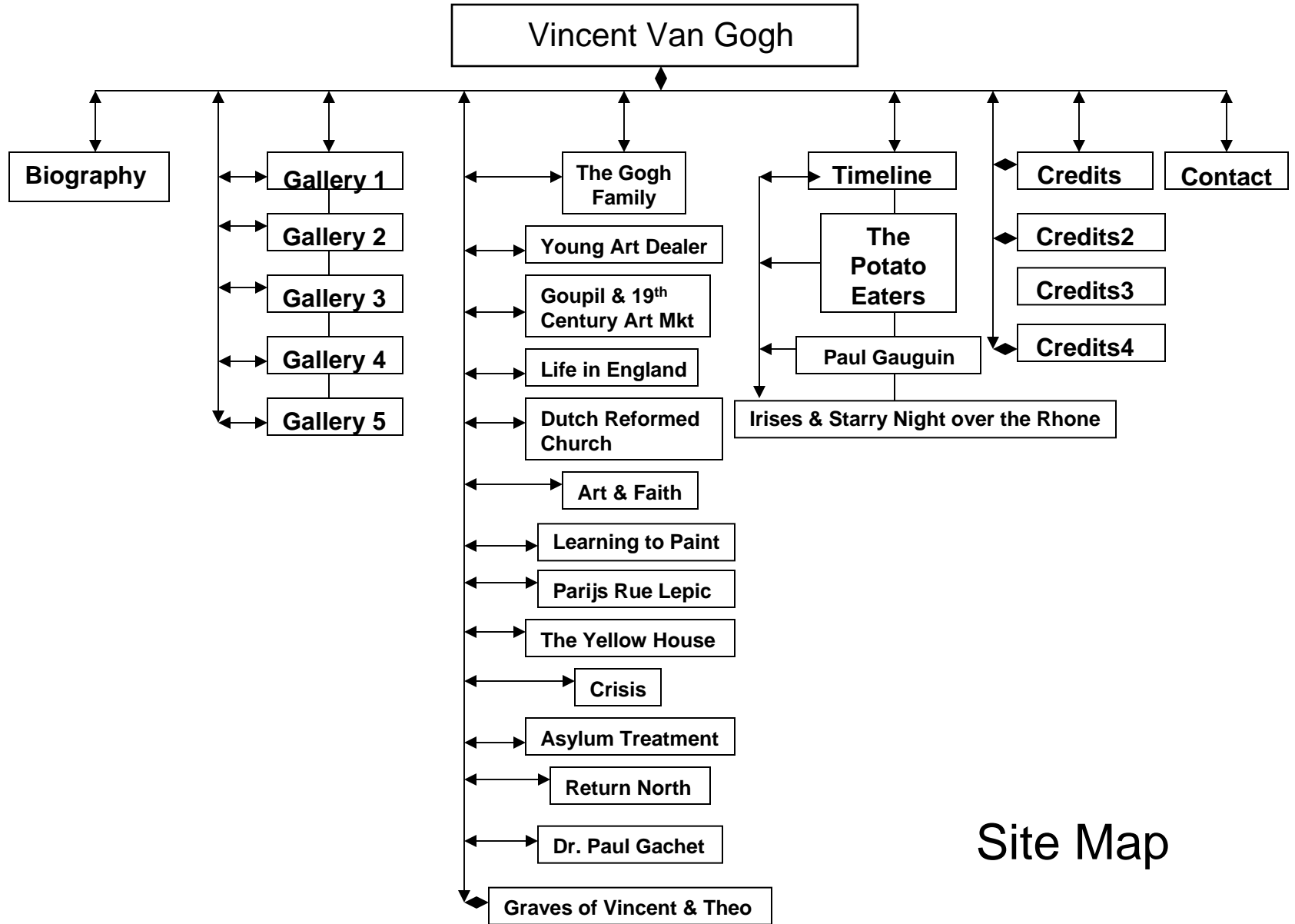
